

Z. B. M. vs. N. R.

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Štovana gospodo iz "Kemije u industriji",

Prije kratkog vremena kolega čiji su inicijali N. R. skrenuo mi je pozornost na članak "O Ciceronu, Katilini i N. R.-u", objavljen u *Kemiji u industriji* 57 (3) (2008) 127. Vidim da je to dio nekakve polemike i/ili svađe između N. R.-a i Z. B. M.-a, koju obojicu imam čast poznavati i koju obojicu veoma cijenim. Polemika između ove dvojice gospode me do te mjere malo zanima da čak ni gore spomenuti članak nisam u potpunosti pročitao. Ipak, primijetio sam da se u završnom dijelu članka spominje moje ime, pa sam taj dio malo pažljivije pogledao.

Kao prvo, veseli me da je Z. B. M. tako pažljivo pročitao jedan naš tekst u *Prirodi* 98 (1) (2008) 42, koji je, inače, bio namijenjen pučko- i srednjoškolicima, te – eventualno – njihovim nastavnicima. Zahvalan sam mu što je uočio krupnu i nedopustivu pogrešku, naime što je ime znanstvenika Binniga bilo napisano Binning. To utoliko prije jer je Z. B. M. imao priliku osobno upoznati tog nobelovca, i to u Heidelbergu (a što je veoma važno glede pravilnog pisanja njegovog imena).

Da prijedem na glavnu stvar: Z. B. M. tvrdi da se N. R. "nadopisao kao koautor" na jednom članku objavljenom u "Prirodi", kojem sam, navodno, ja jedini autor (skupa s još dva moja mlađa suradnika, o čijem nadopisivanju se Z. B. M. nije izjasnio). U tekstu se rabi

i glagol "šlepati", a glavni zaključak je da je "vrlo malo vjerojatno da je to [koautorstvo N. R.-a] rezultat vruće želje troje autora".

Kao iskusni znanstvenik, Z. B. M. je mogao i morao validnost ovih vrlo smjelih zaljučaka provjeriti izravno kod mene, a da ih tek onda upotrijebi u svojoj polemici. Uostalom, tako bi ga sigurno podučio i njegov pokojni profesor Pauš. Da me je pitao, ja bih mom dragom starijem kolegi rekao sljedeće:

[A] Suradnja između mene i N. R.-a nije od jučer. Primjera radi, N. R. i ja imamo zajednički članak objavljen još godine 1999. [B] N. R. je nedavno objavio rad na jednu sličnu temu. [C] I ja, zajedno sa svoja dva mlađa suradnika, nedavno sam objavio rad na istu temu. [D] Ideja da svi zajedno složimo jedan zajednički tekst za "Prirodu" došla je od mene. N. R. je u početku odbijao tu vrstu suradnje, da bi na moje višekratno inzistiranje popustio i pristao. Rad koji je objavljen u "Prirodi" naše je zajedničko djelo, a uvjeren sam ne i posljednje naše zajedničko djelo. [E] Zaključak o tome tko se kod koga "šlepa" ostavljam čitaocima.

Na koncu, kada sam već sve ovo napisao, da dodam i sljedeće: Članci objavljeni u "Prirodi" nisu znanstveni radovi, nego služe za popularizaciju znanosti. Zbog toga je malo važno tko ih je napisao. Važno je da li su napisani tako da ih netko (osobito mladež) čita.

Sabre u Hrvatskoj Besplatne knjige i časopisi

SABRE-Zagreb je neprofitna društvena udruga za prosvjetne, kulturne i humanitarne aktivnosti, koja djeluje u RH od 1989. godine. Od osnivanja udruge SABRE-Zagreb, predsjednica je dr. sc. Helena Pavić, a suradnici, osnivači (10 stručnjaka iz različitih područja).

Ciljevi i zadaci udruge su promicanje i razvoj svjetske znanosti i kulture osiguranjem stalne nabave inozemnih znanstvenih časopisa i znanstvene literature.

Glavna aktivnost udruge su projekti donacije knjiga za RH, nabava medicinskih časopisa u razdoblju 1994.–1996., te nabava suvremenih multimedijalnih obrazovnih materijala za zdravstvene ustanove u RH od 1995. godine.

Udruga nabavlja, izabire i diseminira knjige, časopise i drugi edukacijski materijal američkih izdavača, u suradnji sa SABRE Foundation, Inc., Boston, SAD i US AID-om. Do sada je na taj način nabavljeno i podijeljeno **milijun knjiga, u vrijednosti 25 milijuna USD.**

Knjige su namijenjene akademskoj zajednici RH (nastavnom osoblju i studentima, tj. krajnjim korisnicima svih visokoškolskih ustanova) kao i korisnicima srednjih i osnovnih škola i vrtića.

Kao rezultat desetgodišnjeg rada udruge SABRE-Zagreb, prijavljen je i izrađen znanstveno-istraživački projekt Ministarstva znanosti i tehnologije "Evaluacija desetgodišnjeg rada Fondacije SABRE-Zagreb". Projekt je pozitivno recenziran.

U početku, knjige su bile pohranjene i diseminirane na Veterinarskom fakultetu Sveučilišta u Zagrebu, zatim na Vojnom učilištu Petar Zrinski u Črnomercu i posljednjih osam godina u Nacionalnoj i sveučilišnoj knjižnici.

Za svaku pošiljku knjiga SABRE-Zagreb se natječe i odabire za krajnje korisnike osnovna područja, a nakon toga i naslove udžbenika/knjiga. Sve te poslove obavlja savjet SABRE-a. Pošiljke dolaze u kontejnerima (oko 20 000 knjiga), te se spremaju u skladište. Popis knjiga se stavlja na web Ministarstva, a specijalne knjižnice šalju popise želja. Da bi knjige bile dostupne i pojedincima, svake subote se dijele od 10–14 sati u auli NSK.

Trenutno imamo knjige izdavača Princeton University Press, Harvard University Press, Yale University Press, MIT, McGraw Hill, Guilford i World Book iz područja društveno-humanističkih znanosti, psihijatrije i psihologije, prirodnih znanosti i tehničkih znanosti.

U planu i programu Ministarstva za 2007. godinu predviđene su aktivnosti SABRE-Zagreb (pet pošiljaka) uz financijsku pripomoć za prijevoz knjiga iz SAD-a u RH.

Da bi se čitaoci što detaljnije upoznali s radom SABRE-Zagreb i njegovim doprinosom hrvatskoj znanstvenoj literaturi i baštini, ovdje objavljujemo pitanja SABRE Foundation, Inc. Iz Cambridgea (Mr. Colin McCullough, Book Program Manager) i odgovore dr. sc. Helene Pavić, izvršne direktorice SABRE-Zagreb, na engleskom jeziku, kako bi se stekao što bolji uvid u sve elemente takve suradnje.

Question: 1) Your history/experiences to date of working with Sabre. (Statistical data is particularly welcome in regard to this question)

Answer: Legal basis: The Sabre Foundation was founded in Zagreb, on July 1, 1991.

The Sabre Foundation has been founded as a social foundation to promote cultural, educational, scientific and humanitarian activities. The purpose of the Foundation is to deal with cultural, educational, scientific and humanitarian activities.

The aim of the Foundation is to promote the development of world science and culture through supporting the propagation of scientific information and documents from abroad and, within this context, to ensure the inflow of scientific periodicals and scientific literature in general, as well as to participate in the organization of scientific conference.

The activities are performed on the humanitarian and non-profit basis.

The Foundation shall be managed by its President, its Board of Trustees (the "Board" and its Assembly. Members of the Foundation are its founders (the "Founders"). Dr. Helena Pavić, Zlata Kipčić, former director of the Language High School, in Zagreb, M. Sc. Davor Sovagović, Ministry of Science, Education and Sport, Dr. Katica Ivic, Faculty of Economics of the University J. J. Strossmayer in Osijek, Dr. Dunja Mance, Faculty of Technology and Chemical Engineering of the University of Zagreb, Prof. Tomo Martincić, Faculty of Veterinary Sciences of the University of Zagreb, Prof. Nada Mitin, Faculty of Sciences of the University of Zagreb, Dr. Djuro Njavro, Dean of School of Economics and Management, Zagreb, B. A. Tanja Susec, Chief Librarian of all medical libraries in Croatia, Zagreb, Mr. Mladin Vukmir, lawyer, H. E. Zeljko Urban, former Ambassador of Croatia to Canada and Brazil.

On July 15, 1997, the Foundation was renamed SABRE-Zagreb in accordance with the local laws.

The Foundation SABRE-Zagreb takes part in the Overseas Partnership Contract from July 2, 1991.

Before the official registration, the Foundation was part of the *Almae Matris Alumni Croaticae*.

Question: 2) A description of the beneficiaries of the Sabre Book Program in your country (WITH A PARTICULAR EMPHASIS ON HOW THEY BREAK DOWN BY GENDER AND AGE). I also need information on how you track or estimate the number of beneficiaries, and the techniques you use to determine their book needs (e.g., using surveys, needs assessments)

Answer: The National project entitled Evaluation of the tenth-year period of the Sabre Book Donation Program to Croatia (1991–2001). The project was approved by the Minister of Science and Technology, Prof. Hrvoje Kraljević on April 12, 2001. The main researcher of the project was Prof. Zora Popović from the Faculty of Sciences of the University of Zagreb with participation of:

– The first part of the project refers to the results of the evaluation performed by Dr. Boris Mlacić from the Institute of social sciences "Ivo Pilar". The results refer to one institution but for the entire ten-year period. The results were successfully evaluated followed by new shipments of books.

– The second part of the project referring to the tenth-year period was performed by Prof. Goranka Lugomer, Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences, Dept. of Psychology of the University of Zagreb, Ms. Tanja Susec, Chief Librarian of the special library for biomedicine at the Clinical Hospital "The Sisters of Charity" in Zagreb, Mr. sc. Kata Husnjak, Chief Librarian at the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering and Naval Architecture of the University of Zagreb, and Prof. Zora Popović, Faculty of Sciences of the University of Zagreb. The following students participated in the project: Miss Lada Bradic and Miss Vedrana Bulat, fifth-year students at the Faculty of Medicine of the University of Zagreb, Mr. Danko Skare, graduate student of the Faculty of Law of the University of Zagreb, Miss Jasminka Popović and Mr. Igor Picek, graduate students from the Faculty of Sciences of the University of Zagreb.

The same students are now employed at:

Miss Lada Bradic, M. D. is employed as Assistant at the Faculty of Medicine of the University of Zagreb;

Miss Vedrana Bulat, M. D. is employed as young researcher at the Clinical Hospital "The Sisters of Charity" in Zagreb;

Mr. Danko Skare is employed as an aspirant lawyer in Zagreb.

Miss Jasminka Popović is employed as a young researcher at the Institute "Rudjer Bosković" in Zagreb.

Mr. Igor Picek is employed as a young researcher at the Faculty of Medicine of the University of Zagreb.

Conclusions obtained from the Evaluation of the Project:

– Out of the total number of 421 interviewees (the majority were educational staff) 246 and 103 students, 40 individual end-users, 27 librarians and 5 coordinators. 38 % were using books from the Sabre Book Donation Program for 3 years, 38 % were also using books from the same donation for 4 to 6 years, and 25 % of the interviewees were using books from 7 to 10 years. The majority of the interviewees received donations 2 to 5 times in average.

The largest number of books came from the field of their primary interest, 1 to 3 in the scale referring to technical sciences, 3.3 from the field of sciences, 4.3 from the field of humanities and social sciences, 4.4 from the field of economy.

– The interviewees have in their collections 57 % of books in English, while 35 % of the books were received in the last ten years through the Sabre Book Donation Program. Books published in English and received through Sabre Donation are used mostly by teachers 4.21 (scale 1-5), post-graduate students 4.17 regardless of scientific area of interest.

Donated books were mostly used for scientific and research work 3.47 (in the scale 1-5), for general cultural and amusement purposes 3.39, for teaching courses 3.33 and as textbooks used for exams.

A high level of satisfaction was achieved with regard to the recent publication of books, either in paper form or in electronic media.

– The books were used for scientific and professional development as an invaluable source of information.

– The percentage of received books is very high and so is the satisfaction of end users.

The List of Periodicals received through the Sabre Book Donation Program are attached. They are divided according to the year of their arrival, i. e. periodicals that arrived in 1991, periodicals that refer to the period 1988–1991, periodicals that arrived 1991–1992, periodicals that arrive 1991–1993, periodicals that arrived 1991–1994, periodicals which arrived 1991–1998, periodicals which arrived 1995–1998 and periodicals which arrived (1991–1997).

Question: 3) The value of the Sabre program in comparison to other book donation programs of which you may have had experience.

Answer: We have no experience with other book donation programs except the SABRE.

Question: 4) Any existing cooperation or opportunities you see for cooperation between the Sabre program in your country and other programs, donors or sectors.

Answer: SABRE-Zagreb is participating in the project of the US Embassy in Croatia called American Corners in the Countries of Central and Eastern Europe, concerning books in the field of Americana.

Question: 5) How does the Sabre book program support the long-term development objectives of a) your organization and b) your country as a whole?

Answer: Text of the book Experiment is attached.*

Question: 6) How do the Sabre books respond to the specific needs of the beneficiaries in your country?

Answer: The books from the area of Mental Health were donated to psychiatric clinics in Croatia and especially to the General Hospital in Vukovar. The books are very useful as there are many people suffering from PTSP as a result of post-war trauma.

Question: 7) How does your organization address the issue of assuring that commodities will “do no harm” In other words, do the donated books have any negative effect on local publishing?

Answer: The following publishers HUP, Yale, Princeton, MIT and World Book are not present on the local market, therefore no harm to local publishers.

As far as the Elsevier textbooks are concerned, they are not represented in local books stores, therefore the books received through the Book Donation Program also serve for exhibition purposes.

McGraw Hill textbooks serve as a kind of suggestion to the Ministry of Science, Education and Sport in order to decide what books to be used in the Institutions of Higher Education.

Question: 8) Describe the entire process of receiving and distributing the books, i.e., clearing customs, warehousing, transportation and distribution of books to final destination.

Answer: According to the Offer of the SABRE Inc. and the List of Wishes of our end users (faculties, institutes etc), the selection of the areas of interest is made. Upon the notification of arrival of books, preliminary arrangements for Customs and Forwarders are made (preparation of necessary documentation) and planning of personnel for unloading the container. The National and University Library as a final destination where books are stored should be notified in advance to obtain the permission for storage and to inform the security personnel.

The boxes of books are unloaded and stored according to areas (medicine, economy etc.). All the books are photographed and distributed to already defined end users. The books that are not distributed to end institutions are disseminated every Saturday at the hall of the National and University Library, from 10 am to 2 pm to individual end users. They choose the books by themselves.

Question: 9) Describe in detail how your organization monitors or tracks the shipment from shipping dock to the final distribution. Include the following elements: reporting requirements, physical inspection, inventory control, distribution schedule, on-site inspection and beneficiaries’ response.

Answer: DHL delivery of documents, stamping each book not for resale. Distribution schedule is done in advance. On-site inspection includes inspection of documents and comparison of data marked on the shipping list and the actual status. The beneficiaries’ response can be seen from the Letter of Thanks received from end-users. (attached)*

Question: 10) Describe the steps taken to safeguard the distribution process and to make sure that books are not stolen or resold.

Answer: Each book is stamped Not for Resale.

Question: 11) The inland cost of moving a container from the port of entry to your warehouse. It would be useful if this figure could be provided to me in US dollars.

Answer: The shipments are delivered door to door.

Question: 12) The cost of customs clearance for a container.

Answer: The cost of customs clearance is US\$200.
